Beyond Engineering Event - 19 January, 2026

Beyond Engineering was conducted with the vision of encouraging students to look beyond conventional academic boundaries and engage with real-world problems that exist outside the classroom. The event focused on fostering a mindset where technology, innovation, and empathy come together to create meaningful impact. Students were encouraged to identify challenges faced by rural and underserved communities and propose technology-driven solutions that are practical, inclusive, and socially relevant. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation, with students demonstrating strong problem understanding, social awareness, and a genuine desire to contribute beyond grades or placements. Overall, Beyond Engineering served as a platform that motivated students to think critically about society, understand grassroots issues, and explore how their technical knowledge can be applied for broader social good.

Build for Campus Ideathon - Ongoing
