Job purpose

Dr. Ratnadeep Suri and Dr. Aasim Khan, Department of Social Sciences and Humanities, Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology (IIIT Delhi), are looking to hire two **Research Coordinators** for an international project. - Extensively catalogue data sets and create online data repository by using appropriate software
- To travel extensively in Delhi, and be able to take responsibility of field data collection in remote sites in the city without much support from the team
- Most importantly, the candidate must be able to work collaboratively with those participating in the study. Demonstrable skills in dealing with various social and economic groups will be crucial in the selection.

Qualifications

Hold at least a Master's Degree in any of the relevant social science fields:
 Sociology/Anthropology, Social Work, Science and Technology Studies, Public Policy and other aligned fields.

- Candidate with publication experience preferred.
- Candidates must have high motivation to be part of a field-based study. Having prior experience of field-based research (including ethnographic, survey and qualitative methods) is mandatory.
- The position is best suited for those who are looking to gain research experience while
 developing an interest in the domain or preparing to undertake doctoral research in the
 near future.
