## 1. INVITATION FOR BIDS

Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology -Delhi (IIITD), a State University created by an Act of Govt. of NCT of Delhi, invites sealed bids for **Conducting Post Graduate Computer Science & Engineering Admission Test (PGCAT-IIITD) on Pan-India Level** (as per specifications mentioned under Scope of Work below) for its campus at Okhla Phase-III New Delhi-110020.

1. An amount of Rs.50,000/- ( Fifty thousand Only) towards earnest money (EMD) must be deposited in the form of demand draft in favour of **“IIIT-Delhi Collections”** account, payable at New Delhi. No interest will be paid on the earnest money deposited by the bidder. Tender Document without earnest money will be summarily rejected. EMD is exempted for MSMEs/NSIC registered suppliers
2. The tender document can be downloaded from the Institute's website. Those wishing to get the copy of the document from the Institute may please deposit a non-refundable Tender Document Fee of Rs.1, 180/- (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred Eighty Only) in the form of Demand draft drawn in favour of **IIIT-Delhi Collections**", payable at New Delhi or may deposit Rs.1, 180/-with the F&A division of the Institute and enclose the receipt with the filled up tender document. The tender fee is exempted for MSMEs/NSIC registered suppliers.

## **2. BIDDING PROCEDURE:**

1. Bids are invited in Two Bids System, i.e. (1) Technical and (2) Financial.

Technical and Financial bids should be sealed separately and enclosed in a sealed envelope clearly indicating separately Technical Bid for " **Post Graduate Computer Science & Engineering Admission Test** " and Financial Bid for " **Post Graduate Computer Science & Engineering Admission Test**" addressed to Registrar IIIT-Delhi, Okhla Industrial Area Phase-III, New Delhi-110020.

2. Sealed quotations shall be received no later than 12.00 Noon on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2026. No bids will be accepted after this date & time under any circumstances. The Institute will not be responsible for any postal/courier delay and reasons beyond the Institute's control.

**Technical bids must contain the EMD for specified amount, along with complete technical details as desired by this tender. Technical bids of all the tenderers will be opened on pre scheduled date, time & venue. Technical bids without EMD will be summarily rejected. The financial bid will be opened after evaluation of the technical bid. Financial Bid will open only for those vendors who qualify in the technical evaluation round. The date, time of opening of financial bid will be communicated later. The EMD is exempted for MSMEs/NSIC registered suppliers.**

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## **4. INTRODUCTION**

### **4.1. About IIITD and Request for Proposal**

Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology Delhi (IIIT-Delhi) was created by an Act of Delhi legislature empowering it to carry out R&D, conduct educational programs, and grant degrees. IIIT-Delhi is accelerating on the path to becoming one of the leading comprehensive research-led teaching institutes in India and has proven to be consistently responsive to the evolving needs of society. The faculty members at IIIT-Delhi are among the finest in the country and are internationally recognized. Carrying out cutting-edge research is part of the institutional DNA of IIIT-Delhi.

Tenders are invited from eligible, reputed and qualified IT Firms with sound technical and financial capabilities for implementation and maintenance of Computer Based System for conducting Post Graduate Computer Science & Engineering Admission Test (PGCAT-IIITD) on Pan-India Level as per the detailed out in the Scope of Work of this RFP Document. This invitation to bid is open to all Bidders meeting the pre-qualification criteria as mentioned in this RFP Document.

## 5. SCOPE OF THE WORK

### 5.1. About PGCAT

IIITD administers the Post Graduate Computer Science & Engineering Admission Test (PGCAT-IIITD) Entrance examination specifically designed for both GATE and NON-GATE candidates applying for M.Tech. CSE, M.Tech. Research in CSE and PhD CSE. Programs. The PGCAT Exam comprises single segments:

- a. PGCAT-IIITD Computer-Based Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) Test

### 5.2. Scope of Work

The Scope of Work would include providing of infrastructure (Human Resources-Machine) for the conduct of entrance examination to the following courses as per the time frame tabulated (Tentative) below:

#### 5.2.1. PGCAT-IIITD General Requirements:

- The physically secure and located test centres.
- High-quality standards for exam centres and their locations.
- The platform must be fully functional and available for testing at least one month prior to the examination. The platform should be independently tested by expert(s) from IIITD before the examination date and approved for use.
- By deploying technically qualified, experienced, adequate manpower to manage the entire examination process. There should be at least 2 experienced technical persons directly from the agency managing the LAN (Local area network) and 1 experienced person as Centre head at the test center.
- A mandatory dry run of their platform at IIIT Delhi at least one day before the exam.
- **Establishment of a centralized control room at IIIT Delhi on the examination day** for real-time monitoring and management of the examination process. The control room shall provide live, center-wise dashboards displaying, at a minimum, the following information:
  - (i) number of students currently logged in at each examination centre,
  - (ii) number of students actively taking the examination at each centre, and
  - (iii) number of students who have completed the examination at each centre.
- To obtain connectivity and provide Examination center across the India as per the schemes of different Entrance Examination for different courses as tabulated above and manage them as per requirement.
- To develop, host and manage examination web pages for different Entrance Examinations for different courses and other related links.
- To address the security issues- Providing security software and securing the network systems to establish a highly secured and sanitized system for the entire process.
- Verification of the candidate's identity with the Hall ticket
- Invigilation duty in examination hall.

- Each test centre must have properly maintained and hygienic washroom facilities for both male and female candidates, along with access to safe drinking water.
- Identity check with photo ID card (Govt. of India approved) to avoid impersonation.
- Signature of the candidate in the attendance sheet.
- Ensuring requisite Computer Lab infrastructure including power backup infrastructure, software, adequate software and Security software for the smooth conduct of the examination
- Verification of the signature in the attendance sheet vis-à-vis the signature in the admit card.
- To complete the registration process of the candidates before the start of the examination (digital photo and bio-metric fingerprint capture, etc.) and allow candidates to appear for a test at the Test Centre.
- No books, mobile phones etc. will be allowed inside the center.
- To conduct Computer-Based MCQ Test in a smooth and fair manner in a shortest span of time.
- To authenticate and evaluate the answer responses of the candidates.

### **5.2.2. PGCAT-IIITD Specific Requirements:**

The PGCAT-IIITD is a Computer-Based MCQ Test. The below activities are involved in the administration of the test at each test center.

Specific Requirement:

- The duration of PGCAT-IIITD will be 02 hours.
- Supply of stationery to the candidates.
- Allotment of a computer terminal to the candidate on successful verification.
- Candidates can start the terminal with a specific user ID and password.
- Attendance sheets containing the photographs and signatures at each center.
- Question paper will be provided to the vendor one/two day(s) before the exam for configuring on their platform and the same must be secured using two-key authentication. One key will remain with us and will be disclosed to our representative on the day of exam only.

**Note:** The test center Head, along with at least one technical person per LAN (Server), should be from the bidder's end for each test center for both day i.e, main exam and the mock run.

### **5.2.3. Result Declaration**

- This module should offer the following features and facilities to carry out the post-examination activities effectively.
- The candidate's result is to be linked with the main database.
- The candidate may be able to see his/her mark by entering the credentials in their respective domain.
- Provide the raw data of the examination on the same day of the exam.

### **5.2.4. Other Information**

#### **5.2.4.1. Transfer and Data Retention Period**

The bidder must ensure the handover of all data upon the completion of PGCAT Exam and declaration of result. Additionally, the bidder is obligated to retain this data for a comprehensive period of six months from the date of result declaration.

#### 5.2.4.2. Exam Centre Cities

- It is preferable that each examination centre be located within approximately 10 kilometers of the city's main railway station or airport to ensure ease of access and convenient connectivity for candidates. Locations should be well connected through public transport and easily reachable.
- As a general guideline, only one examination centre should be designated per city. However, an additional centre may be considered in the same city if the number of registered candidates exceeds 200, subject to proper justification, capacity planning, and prior approval from the competent authority.

## **6.2. Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)**

### **1. EVALUATION CRITERIA**

#### Introduction:

The following Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) methodology will be employed to evaluate proposals submitted in response to the tender for providing infrastructure and services for the PAN-INDIA PGCAT exam conducted by IIITD.

#### **Evaluation Criteria:**

### **A. Technical Proposal (70%):**

- **Proposed Plan for Smooth Exam Conduction:** The proposed plan for smooth exam conduction includes a detailed schedule, logistics arrangements, and contingency measures. It also focuses on identifying potential risks and implementing strategies to mitigate them, along with a robust communication plan to coordinate effectively with IIITD and candidates throughout the entire process.
- **Demonstration of Exam Platform:** The demonstration of the exam platform showcases its features, usability, and interactivity, while also assessing its technical stability, including responsiveness and system performance.
- **Presentation in In-person:** The vendor should present a presentation in the IIIT-Delhi campus. Evaluation of the presenter's ability to effectively demonstrate the proposed exam platform and server architecture, showcasing key features and functionalities.
- **Experience and Expertise:** Vendor's track record and experience in conducting similar exams, especially on a PAN-INDIA scale.

### **B. Financial Proposal (30%):**

- **Reasonableness of Cost:** Evaluation of the proposed cost vis-à-vis the services and infrastructure offered.
- **Value for Money:** Assessment of the cost-effectiveness of the proposal in delivering the required services.
- **Transparency and Accountability:** Clarity and transparency in the cost breakdown and any additional charges.
- **The Financial Bid should be valid for a period of not less than 60 days from the date of opening of Bid.**

## **2. EVALUATION PROCESS:**

- **Initial Screening:** Ensure that all proposals meet the minimum eligibility criteria outlined in this tender document. Disqualify any proposals that fail to meet these criteria.
- **Technical Evaluation:** A technical evaluation committee will assess the technical proposals based on the predefined evaluation criteria. Each criterion will be scored individually, and the cumulative score will determine the technical merit of each proposal.
- **Financial Evaluation:** The financial proposals of technically qualified bidders will be opened and evaluated after the technical evaluation. The financial proposals will be scored based on the reasonableness of cost, value for money, and transparency.
- **Composite Score Calculation:** The composite score for each proposal will be calculated by combining the weighted scores from the technical and financial evaluations. The weightage for the technical proposal will be 70%, and for the financial proposal, it will be 30%.
- **Selection:** The bidder with the highest composite score will be selected for awarding the contract, subject to meeting all other terms and conditions specified in the document.

### **Important Note:**

- IIITD may conduct negotiations with the selected bidder to finalize the terms of the contract.

This QCBS methodology aims to ensure a transparent, fair, and objective evaluation process, ultimately leading to the selection of the most qualified bidder offering the best value proposition for the installation of Biometric/Face Recognition Attendance Recorder machines.

### 7. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Upon the declaration of an intending vendor to be the Successful Vendor by the Institute, they shall be subject to the following terms and conditions;

1. Upon placing of the Purchase Order (PO), the successful Bidder is required to submit a performance bank guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 5% of the PO value within 15 days from the date of PO, failing which the Bidder shall be notified as blacklisted. The PBG will be valid for a period of 60 days beyond the stipulated date for cessation of the contract, which is co-terminus with the warranty period. No interest is payable on the PBG.
2. PBG should be in favour of "IIIT-Delhi Collections" payable at New Delhi. PBG will be realized by IIIT-D in case of termination of the contract for unsatisfactory performance and/or non-performance of the contract.
3. The bidder is required to appoint a dedicated Single Point of Contact (SPOC) or Project Manager in coordination with IIIT-Delhi. This individual will assume complete responsibility for overseeing and ensuring the successful execution and timely delivery of all project-related tasks and deliverables
4. The offered solution by the bidder should have capability to make changes or customize the offered platform/solution as per IIIT-Delhi requirements.
5. In the event of the Bidder failing to meet the SLAs, IIIT-Delhi reserves the right to impose fines. A penalty of Rs. 5000/- per day will be levied for the first seven days of breach, and Rs. 8,000/- per day from the 8th day onwards.
6. Suitable emergency management plan toward any crisis situations for server management, node management, additional locations, student/applicant data. In case of failure of the system leading to failure of the examination, the whole examination will be conducted again with cost of the second examination to be borne by the bidder concerned.

7. Ensuring uninterrupted power supply (UPS) is provided to IT infrastructure at every test center, guaranteeing generator availability, and maintaining sufficient air-conditioning in testing laboratories are essential objectives.
8. The bidder should have an in-house quality assurance and product testing professionals with a robust quality management process that are followed to test and certify the system used to conduct the exam. The organization should maintain documented test cases and maintain evidence of successful test execution covering all test cases.
9. Testing should not be limited to system features and functionality. The system used to conduct the exam must be tested for performance, security, Usability, High availability, Business Continuity and disaster recovery.
10. The bidder is strictly prohibited from disclosing the applicant's database to any third party or individual.
11. The bidder should design a high-performance system and conduct performance tests to verify successful achievement of high concurrency, fast response time, and long stress duration required of the system used to conduct the exam. Results of such performance test should be made available for each major release of the system used to conduct the exam.
12. The bidder should design a highly secure system and conduct security tests to verify that there are no vulnerabilities that can make the system susceptible to attacks. Comprehensive testing of source code, software binaries and the infrastructure must be carried out. Results of such security tests should be made available for each major release of the system used to conduct the exam.
13. At any time before the submission of bids, IIIT-Delhi may amend the bid document by issuing an addendum in writing or by standard electronic means.
14. If the amendment is substantial, Bidder(s) shall be given reasonable time to make amendment or to submit revised bid and the deadline for submission of bids will be extended by IIIT-Delhi.
15. The successful vendor shall not assign the sub-contract. In case of breach of these conditions, the IIIT-Delhi may serve a notice in writing on the Contractor rescinding the contract.
16. The successful Vendor shall provide the services strictly in accordance with scope of work, technical specifications and as per detailed instructions of the Institute.
17. In all matters of dispute arising on the work, the matter shall be referred to the Director IIIT-Delhi for a decision.
18. **Arbitration Clause:** In the event that the Successful Vendor is not satisfied by the mutual decision of IIIT-Delhi, the dispute shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any enactment thereof. The Arbitral Tribunal shall consist of one arbitrator, to be appointed by the Institute. The place of arbitration shall be Delhi and any award whether interim or final, shall be made, and shall be deemed for all purposes between the parties to be made in Delhi. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in the English language and any award or awards shall be rendered in the English language. The procedural law of the arbitration shall be the Indian law. The award of the arbitral tribunal shall be final, conclusive and binding upon the Successful Vendor and the Institute.
19. **Penalty Clause:** The completion period mentioned in work order shall be strictly observed by the successful vendor and it shall be reckoned within one week of issue of work order. The work shall throughout the stipulated period of the contract be preceded with all the due diligence and if the successful vendor fails to complete the work within the specified period, they shall be liable to pay compensation at the rate of 1% per week subject to a maximum amount of 10 % of the contract amount. The successful vendor shall before commence work prepare a detailed work program which shall be approved by the Institute.

**20. Termination Clause:**

- a. Without prejudice to any other remedy available to the Institute, in case of default on the part of the vendor in the performance of this contract or in the discharge of any contractual obligations arising out of this contract or if the vendor commits substantial breach of his obligations and such breach is not corrected within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of the notice specifying the breach, by the contractor, the Institute may terminate this contract by giving a 30 (thirty) days written notice of intended termination to the vendor.
- b. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, the Institute may terminate this contract at any time by giving one month's notice to the Contractor without assigning any reason thereof and without prejudice to the rights of the Institute to recover any money becoming due and payable to the Institute under this Contract.
- c. Forthwith on the expiry or earlier termination of this Contract, the vendor shall, return to the Institute all materials and equipment, belonging to the Institute with regard to this Contract. The Institute shall also intimate to the vendor a time when it can collect its equipment stored in the Institute and the vendor shall collect the same. In the event that the vendor does not collect its equipment by the appointed time, the Institute shall not be liable for the same thereafter.
- d. Forthwith on the expiry or earlier termination of this Contract, the Institute shall determine the costs of execution, cost of remedying any defects (if any) and the cost of completion of the work (if required). The Institute shall be entitled to recover from the Contractor the extra costs, if incurred, after adjusting the same against the Performance Security Deposit made by the Contractor.
- e. On the earlier termination of this Contract due to failure to discharge its duties, the Performance Security Deposit shall stand forfeited by the Institute.

I/We hereby declare that I/we have read and understood the above terms and conditions. The same shall be binding upon me/us upon being declared as the Successful Vendor.
